ARTISTIC PROGRAMMING

The Symphonia provides South Florida with outstanding orchestral chamber music. Our balanced and distinctive programs include both the classics and contemporary works by modern masters.

OUTREACH

The Symphonia strives to engage underserved members of our community. Our Strings and Self-Esteem program is partnered with the Boys & Girls Club of Delray Beach. In addition, we provide free concert tickets for special-needs adults from the Schwedelson Sunday Social Scene at the Levis JCC; community members from Boca Helping Hands and Lighthouse for the Blind; and veterans, through the Wounded Veterans Relief Fund.

EDUCATION

The Symphonia offers various educational programs that serve all ages. At Meet the Orchestra sessions, children and their caregivers develop a hands-on appreciation of musical instruments. Our Box Lunch It program provides opportunities to sit in on rehearsals and learn how concerts are produced. Special pre-concert conversations with our conductor and soloists are included with the purchase of any subscription or single-concert ticket.

COMMUNITY COLLABORATION

The Symphonia collaborates with other organizations—including Festival of the Arts BOCA, City of Boca Raton, Boca Ballet Theatre, and Milagro Center—to further strengthen the bonds created through art and culture within our local community.
